Year 13 students are offered the same options for 2 hours per fortnight on an optional basis.

Students opt for Sixth Form subjects following a series of guidance sessions through tutorials and assemblies, starting in February of Year 11, or through a meeting with a member of the Sixth Form team for external students. Final subjects are selected in August after results are received.

Following End of Year 12 Assessments, and guidance meetings where appropriate, students will enrol into Year 13 at the end of Year 12. They will either continue with 3 or 4 A' Level subjects, or may opt for a combination of AS and A' Level subjects if they have chosen to sit an AS exam in year 12.
