### **Rotations and layout**

Focus	Outline
Introduction lesson – British values	Establishing what key values are and exploring the designated ‘British values’ Reflecting on their own values and how we see them presented in society.
Introduction lesson – ICT, Unifrog and baseline quiz	Introducing students to the use of ICT in school and accessing homework and the necessary apps on their own devices. Completing baseline quiz/form to establish known key terms and prior learning. Used to demonstrate progression and increase confidence as topics are covered further throughout the year.

Rotation 2	Beliefs/Citizenship & careers/Digital Literacy/Relationships & wellbeing
Mid-year review	Mind map ‘show me what you know’ activity on the first 2 modules undertaken, key terms and further questions on task sheet. Students then need to complete the review Microsoft Form by selecting the appropriate ‘I can’ statement responses from the lists for the 2 modules completed so far.
Rotation 3	Beliefs/Citizenship & careers/Digital Literacy/Relationships & wellbeing
Rotation 4	Beliefs/Citizenship & careers/Digital Literacy/Relationships & wellbeing
End of year review	Mind map ‘show me what you know’ activity on the last 2 modules undertaken, key terms and further questions on task sheet. Students then need to complete the review Microsoft Form by selecting the appropriate ‘I can’ statement responses from the lists for the 2 modules completed most recently.

### **8 Week rotation modules**

Module 1	Digital Literacy
lesson 1	Making safe choices - Understanding fake news, how what you see can be targeted and the risk of radicalisation through what you are exposed to.
lesson 2	Protecting your identity online – Risks of sharing personal information online
lesson 3	Cybercrime – Understanding types of cybercrime, causes and consequences and recognising when you could be victim to a scam
Lesson 4	Ai and the future of digital literacy
lesson 5	What is a computer? - Understanding input, process, output and the various parts that make up computers.
lesson 6	Programming and coding 1- recap of python language and how it can be used. Also covering the importance of coding and it’s role in future careers etc. Introduce coding challenges.

lesson 7	Programming and decision making – understanding what an algorithm is and how they are used in the digital world that student's engage with. Continue Python coding challenges.
lesson 8	Computing languages – Understanding that there are different types of computing language and that they are used in different contexts. Particular focus on binary language. Continued work on programming challenges with Python.

<b>Module 2</b>	<b>Beliefs</b>
lesson 1	What is a belief? Differences between different belief types focusing on superstitions and religion. Why and how people show belief.
lesson 2	World religions – Understanding different religions around the world. Buddhism, Judaism, Hinduism, Islam, Christianity and Sikhism. How are they represented?
lesson 3	Expressing religion – Exploration of how religions are expressed including through clothing, pilgrimages, and celebrations.
lesson 4	Festivals and celebration
lesson 5	Evil and suffering
lesson 6	Persecution and tolerance – focus on definition of religious persecution and religious tolerance. Case studies of examples of persecution and lack of tolerance (Christianity in Roman Empire, Jewish persecution in the Holocaust and Rohingya Muslims).
lesson 7	Religious views on life and death
lesson 8	Ethical dilemmas

lesson 1	The importance of healthy relationships (types of relationships, including abusive. Recognising the signs of abuse and knowing where to go for support)
lesson 2	Intimate relationships and Consent - When is the right time to have sex? Consent/ peer pressure/healthy sexual relationships.
lesson 3	Nudes and sexting
lesson 4	Exploitation
lesson 5	Contraception
lesson 6	Different people, different choices – sexual health and fgm
lesson 7	How substances can affect your judgement
lesson 8	Making choices about your health
