All classes are taught in mixed ability groups, except Mathematics which is set. Science is mostly taught in mixed ability with the exception of the Triple Science qualification, a cohort of approximately of our 60 most motivated and able science students and two foundation groups to give additional support to a small number of students who find science very challenging. In Year 10 and Year 11 a small number of students work on English and Maths Functional Skills in dedicated groups.

Students select their option subjects following a guidance meeting with a senior member of staff in January. There are no guided routes and students are advised to do subjects they will enjoy, be successful in and which feed into future career plans.
